Information observatory of Myokendake

* **Thrill** : Utmost thrilling and dreamlike charm occupies you tourists only in this Unzen Rope Way turning over floating clouds at the height of 1,334 meters above sea level.

The safety first Rope Way will never fail to meet your complete satisfaction.

* **In Spring** : Tourists can enjoy the extensive view of tsutsujis (acalea) in their best spreading themselves from Yumachi and Jigoku Zone up to Nita-toge and all over the Golf Links.

* **In Summer** : The whole view of fresh green Unzen can vastly commanded. At the top it is ever as cool as in Hokkaido.

* **In Autumn** : An enchanting view of autumnal tints of peaks of Fugen, Myoken and Kunimi can be fully enjoyed.

* **In Winter** : Beautiful sights of a crystal world of frost flowers indigenous to Mt. Unzen can be enjoyed from this rope way.

Unzen Rope Way is thus serving you in all the seasons as a most modern-sensed sightseeing facility.

UNZEN ROPEWAY

This is the first National Park Sightseeing rope way in Japan, running over a valley, 178 meters deep between Nita-toge (Unzen National Park) and the top of Myokendake, 1,334 meters high, in front of Fukendake.


1. Model : Three ways Sight seeing Passenger Rope Way.
2. Dragon : Capacity of 36 Passengers
3. Distance : 500 meters : 3 minutes' ride.
4. Construction cost : US \$ 305,600. - (110,000,000 Yen)
5. Opening Date : July 15, 1957.
6. Required Construction Time : 10 months.

* **View** : Unzen National Park, famous for its ever-attracting natural beauty, has long been the most popular sightseeing resort, where both foreign and domestic tourists often visit.






Fresh green in summer

Grill & Stall



Unzen Rope way

1. Section : Nita-toge Myokendake.
2. Operation : From 8.30 A.M. to 5.15 P.M. (to be occasionally prolonged)
3. Operation Frequency : every 4 minutes. One way 3 minutes ride.
4. Capacity : 36 adults (55 children)
5. Fare : Both ways 140 yen (adult) 70 yen (child) One way 80 yen (adult) 50 yen (child) (Party trip reduction possible)




The whole view of Mt. Unzen seen from Myokendake.

(The most popular Sightseeing course)
 * From Nagasaki : Through buses for Unzen available every an hour from 7.30 A.M. to 6.20 P.M. 2 hrs by taxi.
 * From Isahaya, Obama, Shimabara : Buses available running most often. 30 mins by taxi.
 * From Fukuoka : 5 hrs by way of Omura (by Nishitetsu tram car) and Shimabara (by Steam boat).
 * To Amakusa : Steamboats for Onike (by way of Obama or Ariye by bus) available. Also steamboats for Hondo by way of Yushima available from Shimabara.
 * To Nita-toge (Dona, Waka, Prefecture)
